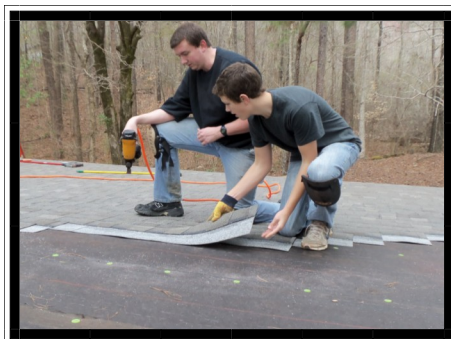
- Painting
